- Bronchiolitis obliterans is a histological diagnosis which can have a variety of causes.
- There is value in classifying it into 2 groups, these being post infectious bronchiolitis obliterans (PIBO); and bronchiolitis obliterans arising from other causes
- PIBO has a fairly good prognosis even without intervention, as long as the child survives the early period

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
